Dear Parents/ Carers,

As you know from previous correspondence, I have organised pedestrian training for each pupil in Reception class.

The training will be led by a fully trained Road Safety Assistant (RSA) from Peterborough City Council. The RSA will work alongside a group of 6 children with their parent/carer, however each parent/carer is responsible for the safety of their child during the training.

The training sessions have been booked for 24th, 25th and 26th June, which will be all morning sessions beginning at 9:30 am.

The sessions last approximately 20 minutes and each child must be accompanied by an adult. Any siblings that accompany must be in pushchairs for insurance purposes and to ensure that the adult can fully concentrate on the child taking part in the training.

Whilst we will aim to provide you with your chosen time/ day, there may need to be some flexibility in order to ensure that all children are able to take part in this opportunity. Therefore I ask if you could tick as many days as possible.

We fully understand that due to work constraints some parent/carers may find it difficult to attend the session. If this is the case, you may like to ask a grandparent or other family member to attend in your place. If all other options have been exhausted, please approach an adult from the Reception team and we will endeavour to provide an adult from within school to support your child within the pedestrian training session.

I have included an outline of the training session 'Stepping Out Together' for you to gain an understanding of the aims, objectives and expected outcomes of the session.

If you would like your child to take part in this opportunity, please complete the form below and return it to school by Thursday 18th June. Parents/ Carers will be informed of their session time by letter on Friday 19th June. Any slips not returned by this date will be allocated a time once the form is returned. If the form is not returned we will assume that you do not wish for your child to take part in pedestrian training.

If you have received this letter via *Parentmail* and would like a paper copy of the reply slip, there are copies available on the Reception Parent/Carer noticeboard and within the letter rack in the foyer next to the school office.
